"Does calling for the genocide of Jews violate Penn's code of conduct, yes or no?" Rep. Elise Stefanik (R-NY) grilled Penn President Liz Magill.

Her answer? It all depends ...

"If the speech turns into harassment, it can be harassment, yes," Magill dodged, adding, "It is a context-dependent decision."

The presidents of Harvard and MIT said much the same. Let me be clear. NO "context" can ever justify calling for the genocide of Jews!

Despite Biden, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is determined to wage the war "until the end" and to secure "total victory" against Hamas.

"Ultimately this is our war.

Ultimately, we have to make the decisions. Ultimately, we do make the decisions," Netanyahu said in December. "We try and often succeed in convincing our American friends. I hope and believe that will be the case in the future."
