

DEAR FRIEND OF ISRAEL,

Joe Biden is betraying Israel.

He wants to give Palestinians their own state next door to Israel. That means creating a radical Islamic terror state side by side with the Jewish state of Israel. And doing so right after Hamas — the terrorist next door — slaughtered more than 1,200 Jews.

It's absurd and unthinkable. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu rejects the idea, saying it "would endanger the state of Israel."

Netanyahu warns that a Palestinian state on Israel's border would become a <u>launching pad for attacks</u> <u>on Israel</u> — exactly what happened on Oct. 7. (Biden dislikes Bibi. He reportedly trashes Israel's PM, privately calling him a "bad f----- guy.")

And Team Biden thinks it knows better than Netanyahu. A "pathway to a Palestinian state" is Israel's one hope to "get genuine security," insists U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken.

He's dead wrong ... and I'll show you why. But first, here's what Biden is up to and the base motivation behind his twostate push.

JOE'S DILEMMA

Biden faces a big threat to his political future. <u>Crowds heckle him on the</u> <u>campaign trail, chanting, "Genocide Joe</u> <u>has got to go</u>!" They wave Palestinian flags and hold up "Abandon Biden" signs.

In Michigan — a state Biden needs in November — Rep. Rashida Tlaib (D-MI) accused Joe of supporting "the genocide of the Palestinian people." The publisher of a Dearborn-based newspaper branded Biden a "war criminal."

And a stunning 54% of Democrats nationwide disapprove of his handling of the war. So, what does Biden do?

Simple. Betray Israel and reward Hamas — the sadistic and bloodsoaked terror group that staged a one-day genocide on Oct. 7, and which exists to <u>erase Israel and destroy the</u> Jewish people.

JOE'S DESPICABLE GAMBIT

Biden's mouthpiece at the *New York Times,* columnist Thomas Friedman, revealed last month that Biden is developing "an unprecedented U.S. diplomatic initiative to promote a Palestinian state — NOW."

Friedman says the so-called "Biden Doctrine" involves "some form of U.S. recognition of a demilitarized Palestinian state in the West Bank and Gaza Strip."

In other words, Joe wants to unilaterally recognize the nonexistent nation of "Palestine." That politically driven plan rewards the terrorists in Ramallah and Gaza with their own independent state. It also places enormous pressure on Israel to give up some of its God-given land to ENEMIES bent on wiping the Jewish state off the map.

That's monstrous ... but this makes it even worse. Joe is pushing this outrageous plan just four months after

Hamas struck Israel with the most bloody and barbarous attack on Jews since the Holocaust.

Joe's big initiative arrives at the very moment heroic Israeli soldiers are fighting Hamas above and below ground in a war to ensure Israel never again faces a genocidal threat from a next-door neighbor.

But instead of standing with Israel, Joe's plan would ensure another enemy state will pop up soon on Israel's border!

And the motivating factor behind all this cynical gamesmanship is **saving Joe's own political hide.**

It's despicable ... and demands our response.

I'd like to tell you why the misnamed "two-state solution" is such a bad idea.

4 REASONS IT'S A TWO-STATE FRAUD

First, <u>this alleged solution has never</u> <u>solved anything</u>. Its track record of failure stretches back to the 1930s.

Hamas-ruled Gaza is the most spectacular flop of this purported solution. Israel left the coastal enclave in 2005, after which Hamas quickly took power. Burning with Jew-hatred, Hamas wasted no time. It soon began **terrorizing a whole generation of Israelis** by its indiscriminate rocket fire on the Jewish state's towns and cities.

In time, <u>Hamas spent billions to build</u> <u>a tunnel-riddled terror base</u> clogged with rockets, munitions, and more. Right on the Jewish state's southern border.

Second, after Oct. 7, some 65% of Israelis reject "land for peace." They don't want to give Israeli land to Palestinians in order to buy peace with a terror state next door.

Palestinians don't want two states, either! Sixty-four percent reject land-forpeace. Instead, 72% think Hamas did the right thing in its sadistic surprise attack on innocent Israeli civilians. And in another respected poll, exactly zero percent of Palestinians in Judea and Samaria see the barbarous Hamas invasion on 10/7 as illegitimate!

Hamas leader Yahya Sinwar summarized Palestinian hopes in 2018 when he declared: "We will take down the border (with Israel) and we will tear out their hearts from their bodies." Oct. 7 shows he meant it.

For his part, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is resolved to eliminate Hamas and achieve total victory. Speaking Jan. 27 on International Holocaust Remembrance Day, he insisted:

We will never forget the atrocities of Oct. 7. We will never forget the massacre, the rapes, the murders and the mutilations. We will never forget the abductions.

Third, Israel has a legitimate and ironclad legal claim to its land — including Judea and Samaria, based on land settlements made by the World War I victors at the San Remo conference in April 1920. Those settlements were implemented through the Palestine Mandate that put into effect a "national home for the Jewish people."

Fourth, God has given Israel specific land promises that remain in force. Western leaders ignore God's Word, treating it as obsolete, but these promises are true and give the Jewish people their ultimate title to the Holy Land.

Abraham was in Hebron, an ancient city in what the world now calls the "West Bank," when God gave the father of the Jewish people this awesome eternal promise:

... I will give to you and to your offspring after you ... all the land of Canaan, <u>for an</u> <u>everlasting possession</u>, and I will be their God (Gen. 17:8).

GOD: "I WILL PLANT THEM IN THIS LAND"

Now, God is returning the Jewish people to their ancestral, God-given land. And He is planting them in it — a project to which He is pledged and fully committed:

Behold, I will gather them from all the countries to which I drove them in my anger and my wrath and in great indignation. I will bring them back to this place, and I will make them dwell in safety. ... I will plant



them in this land in faithfulness, with all my heart and all my soul (Jer. 32:37, 41).

But Joe Biden thinks he can ignore Scripture and divide up the Jewish people's God-given land, handing a portion to Israel's implacable Islamic enemies. And thereby ensuring, he hopes, a return to the White House.

It's a fool's errand and certain to fail, but an initiative that could, in the process, bring great suffering to the Jewish people — as Oct. 7 clearly demonstrates.
